The Epilepsy Association has updated its COVID-19 work plan which now allows for its employees to work from the office. Therefore, beginning on June 8 all staff will be working from the EA office although visitors will not be permitted entry and programming will remain remote until further notice. We take seriously our responsibility to protect our community in light of this pandemic, and we have come to these decisions by following the most current recommendations from the CDC, the Ohio Department of Health, and the Cuyahoga County Department of Health. We want our community to remain informed, and since this is a rapidly evolving situation, our work plans could shift with little notice based on new information or recommendations provided by the state or federal authorities.
