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Epilepsy Association Changes Charity Run name from 'eRACE' to "Race the River" *Community race event helps raise awareness for epilepsy*

CLEVELAND, OHIO – May 25, 2018-- The Epilepsy Association, a local 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, is hosting its sixth annual run at Merwin's Wharf in Cleveland. The race, formerly 'eRACE 5K & 1 Mile,' is now '*Race the River 10K, 5K and 1 Mile*'.
